#1. Install a fresh copy of Windows 7. #2. Delete all three copies of your Windows 7 media and the System Restore Point. #3. Make sure your activation has not expired. Go to #4. Download the Win7-Media-Fix tool and run it. It should fix the problem and allow you to activate Windows. #5. Open your PC with a device you can update. #6. Boot the PC to the recovery console. Use the Windows button and R on your keyboard to enter the recovery console. #7. Install the latest drivers for your laptop, modem, graphics card, etc. #8. Run Windows Update. #9. Restore the Windows 7 Media that you have deleted. #10. Go to and click Download. Clicking on the link will download the.rar file and it will be in the file selection box when you download the file. #11. Open the.rar file and extract the ZIP file. #12. Double click the LINK file and follow the directions. #13. Follow the directions and click on Next after reading the license agreement. #14. Once the system boots up, click on the Start button, and then click on Run, and then type (with quotations). #15. Copy and paste the link that you received in STEP 5 into the line and click Next. #16. Press Enter when Windows appears. #17. Click on Yes. #18. Click Finish and wait for the computer to reboot. #19. Upon reboot, follow the directions to activate Windows 7.
